

ATTENTION PARENTS OF GRADE 5 STUDENTS

Intensive Core French (ICF) is a second language teaching approach in which students in Grade 6 spend 80% of school time learning French during the first half of the school year, and 20% in the second half. This method increases their French communication skills significantly compared to the regular Core French. The remaining curricula (except for Mathematics) are “compressed” into the second half of the year.

This program is for students who will be entering Grade 6 next September and is only offered at Windebank Elementary. Students continue the ICF program at Heritage Park Middle School in Grade 7, 8, and 9. Intensive Core French is a program of choice, part of the Public-School system and cross-boundary registrations are accepted. Students do not need French language knowledge or background to participate and there is no cost to participate.
